

# Priest River Downtown Revitalization

## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

For several years now, Priest River has been gearing up for a project that will revitalize a portion of our downtown. With a completed design, funding in place, and a contractor on-board, the time is finally here! Starting up in mid-May, construction crews will begin to arrive at the site to begin construction activities. Overall construction is expected to take approximately 3 months.

During construction there will be road closures and occasional inconveniences. That said, we'll do everything we can to minimize them.

## PARKING

On-street parking within the project limits will be unavailable during construction. However, City-owned parking lots will be available for the public during this project. One is located north of City Hall (across High Street). A second gravel lot is located directly south of the park at the southeast corner of Main & High Street. See picture for locations.



## SCHEDULE AND TIMBER DAYS

Construction schedules are fluid in nature and depend greatly on weather. The current plan is to begin construction on May 15<sup>th</sup> and finish up at the end of July or beginning of August. The contractor is required to have *High Street* paved and concrete sidewalks installed by July 25<sup>th</sup> to accommodate the activities (car show & parade) associated with Timber Days, which begins on July 26<sup>th</sup>.
