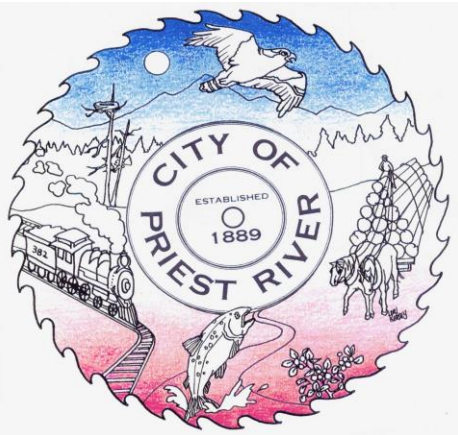

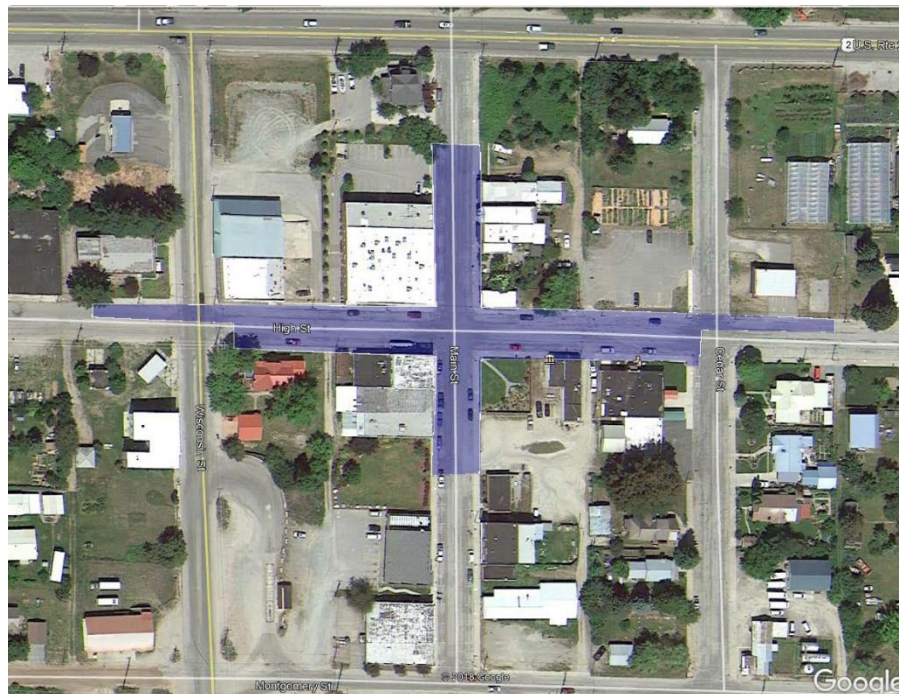


DOWNTOWN REVITALIZATION

Construction has begun! Construction schedules are fluid in nature and depend greatly on weather. The current plan is to finish up at the end of July or beginning of August. The contractor is required to have High Street paved and concrete sidewalks installed by July 25th to accommodate the activities (car show and parade) associated with Timber Days, which begins on July 26th.

On-street parking within the project limits will be unavailable during construction, but two City-owned parking lots are available. One is located north of City Hall (across High Street) and the other gravel lot is located directly south of the park at the southeast corner of Main and High Street.

Thank you for your patience during construction, and make sure to check out our revitalized downtown in August!



PLANNING A PARTY? RESERVE THE PARK!

Are you planning a party at one of the City's parks but worried about other events that might be happening at the same time? Reserve the park to guarantee your spot! Reservation forms are available at City Hall, and the per-day fees are reflected in the table below. A refundable cleaning deposit is also required at the time of reservation (\$50.00 for a small event and \$150.00 for a large event).
